

Does WI Subchapter P Apply To You?



- Count P-coded waste as part of your total hazardous waste
- Waste will ship on a BOL
- Segregate P-coded waste/document under 2.2 lbs.

BENEFITS

- No timeline for disposal
- Less regulatory requirements

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- In section D, question number 1 fill in "Yes"
- Select "A: as a healthcare facility
- You will receive an EPA ID number
- Waste will ship on a manifest
- EAP ID number must be included on manifests and labels

Notify your hazardous waste transporter of your new EPA ID number regulated hazardous wastes" with respect to hazardous waste pharmaceuticals. However, you need to fill out this box for other hazardous waste generated onsite.

Notify your hazardous waste transporter if your generator status or EPA ID number changes.

BENEFITS

- Hazardous waste pharmaceuticals no longer count toward your monthly hazardous waste totals
- Acutely hazardous pharmaceutical waste (P-coded waste) no longer needs to be segregated
- Have up to a year from the date items were first placed inside your "Hazardous Waste Pharmaceuticals' labeled container to remove it
